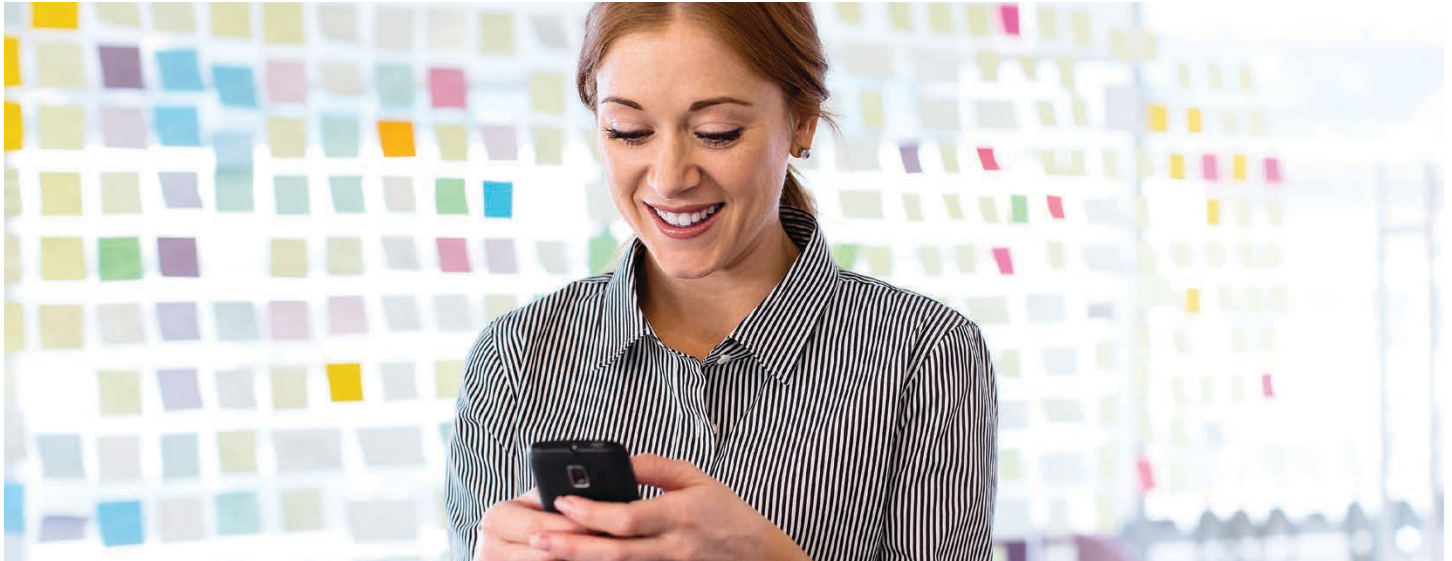

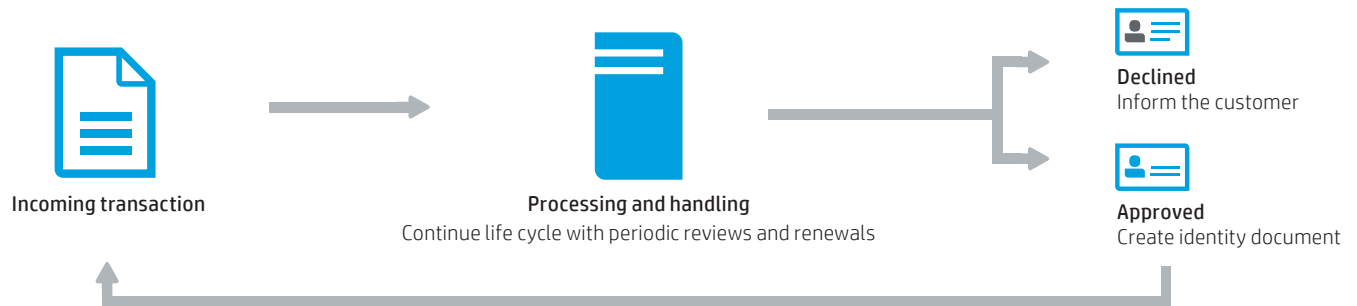
enrollment applications. Consider capturing evidence of identity for human resources, security policy implementations, professional licensing, or even membership enrollment. The solution includes the following features:
