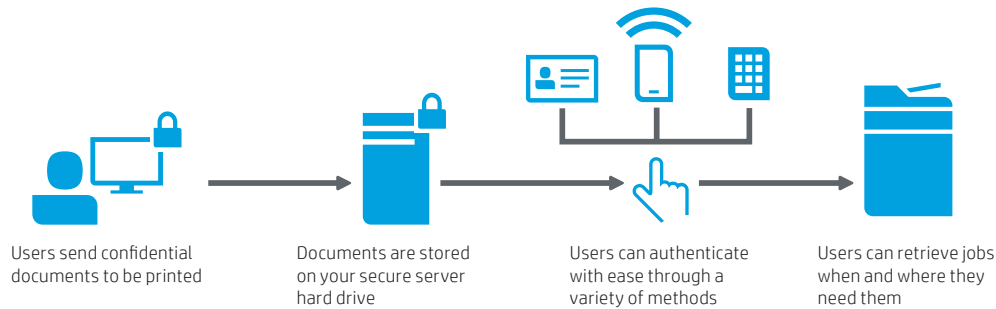

### Deliver jobs to the right user, every time

Store documents on your secure server hard drive, and give users the ability to authenticate to release their specific print job. The job remains in the queue until confirmed and released by the user, and is then printed on the spot—to any solution-enabled device on the network.

### Authenticate with ease

Set up simple user authentication directly at the device, using HP proximity card readers, alpha-numeric personal identification codes (PIC), personal identification number codes (PIN), or smart cards.

### Store and secure confidential documents

Help ensure that only the user who sent the print job may retrieve it. Jobs can be encrypted both in transit and on the printer's secure hard drive. Even enable HP Access Control Secure Pull Printing without using a server.

### Streamline print queues

Reduce the amount of managed print queues. Users can pull select print jobs directly and securely from device print queues—even use the “select all” button to print an entire set of documents.

### Print from virtually anywhere within your network<sup>1</sup>

Enable users to retrieve documents using a smartphone or other mobile device. The HP Access Control Mobile Release allows users to send a job to a specific queue, authenticate using a smartphone or mobile device, preview their job list, and then select and print it.

### Reduce costs and unclaimed jobs

Establish policies that promote responsible printing practices and help conserve paper and energy. Automatically delete unclaimed print jobs after a designated period of time.
