The HP Officejet Pro X 576dw Multifunction Printer (MFP) provides the speed and quality that enables the bank to jump through hoops for its customers.

Duwayne Engelhardt, Vice-President/ Information Security Officer & Network Administrator, Wallis State Bank, tested a HP Officejet Pro X576dw MFP in a busy loan department. Supporting a team of eight people, the high speed of the printer enables Engelhardt to support more people with a single device. He says, “We tried most of its capabilities: wired and wireless networking, scanning to folders, scanning to email and ePrint—and it has worked flawlessly”.

## **Innovative features mean new office efficiencies**

The team put the printer through its paces—and prefers the Officejet Pro X to color laser printers. For instance, the ePrint<sup>2</sup> and Apple® AirPrint™<sup>4</sup> enabled devices allow users to easily print from a smart phone, notebook computer or mobile device. Engelhardt says he uses it himself, to send emails to the printer when he’s in another office 250 miles away, or to print pictures from a remote data closet. “It’s incredibly convenient, does a great job of printing, and keeps productivity up no matter where you are,” he explains.

The scan-to-network folder is another feature that gets high marks. The loan department leaned on the Officejet Pro X printer for this capability when a larger MFP went down. Engelhardt says they found the Officejet Pro X very easy to use because most parameters could be changed directly from one easy-to-use control panel screen; on the other machine it took two screens to change size parameters.

Overall, the loan team and Engelhardt found the Officejet Pro X to be designed for convenience: the 500-sheet paper tray takes a full ream of paper—no need for frequent refilling or storing partial reams elsewhere. Great quality prints the first time means no reprinting is necessary, and according to Engelhardt, the “set-up is smooth as silk, working well on both wired and wireless networks without a hitch”. He also noted that the printer produces brilliant pages with the same PageWide Technology found in top-end digital presses.

## High performance delivered with cost savings

Engelhardt says that the quality of the HP Officejet Pro X is more remarkable given the cost savings that accompany it. With cost per page up to half that of color lasers<sup>3</sup>, he says, “the only thing that comes close is a large \$25,000 printer we have for big jobs and for 11x17 printing.” He explains that by comparison, the Officejet Pro X is easier to use, much less expensive for initial purchase, and continues to save on every page printed.

Impressed with the Officejet Pro X 576 model, Engelhardt recently purchased an HP Officejet Pro X476dn Multifunction Printer to support four people in the CEO suite. He says that the CEO has been pleasantly surprised that jobs that would take his previous color laser up to five minutes to print now take less than 30 seconds on the Officejet Pro X. Engelhardt adds that he is now recommending that the only color printers Wallis State Bank purchases are HP Officejet Pro X printers.
