By configuring your devices' BIOS settings at the factory, you save time and resources.

You can also integrate your branding into your users' everyday work lives with the HP Customer Logo BIOS Setting Service, in which HP can modify the device BIOS or firmware to include your logo for visibility during the boot process. This ensures consistent BIOS logo setting around the world by leveraging HP's automated factory processes when your device is being built.

Meanwhile, the HP BIOS Revision Control Service provides the configuration of BIOS settings to a release you specify for compatible HP devices, allowing for older BIOS version installations on newer devices. By ensuring the stability of business applications, you keep your end users productive—and reduce the time your help desk personnel must assist them.

We can also keep your IT team focused on strategic initiatives with HP Intel® vPro™ Setup and Configuration, a service in which HP configures your Advanced Management Technology (AMT) capable devices according to Intel® vPro™ parameters and supported features on supported devices.
