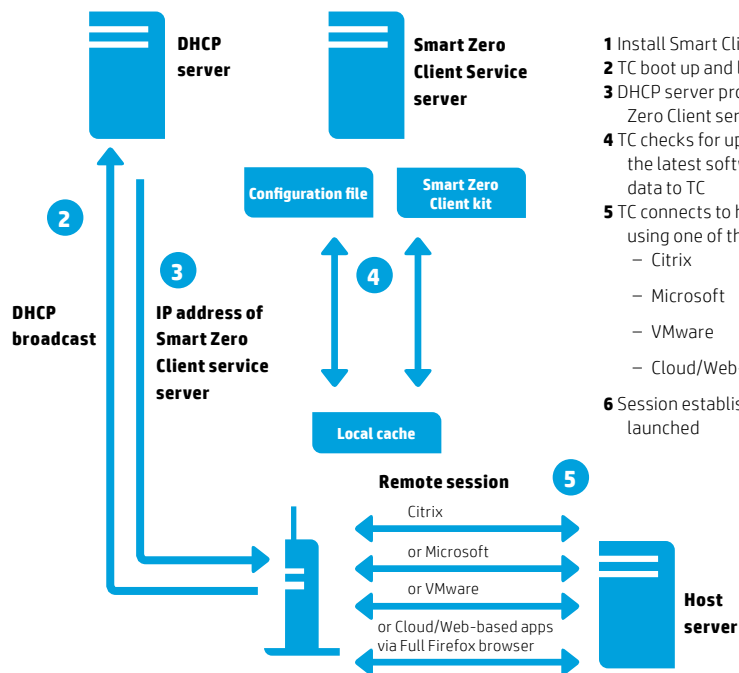

Deploy for Citrix XenDesktop with support for HDX, VMware View via PCoIP, Microsoft Session Virtualization via RDP, or cloud and web-based applications through a full Firefox browser. HP Smart Client Services, installed in the data center at the administrator console, enables new software infrastructure configurations. On the next boot, the no-touch devices automatically inherit configuration from the data center as operable in local mode or as stateless, locked-down clients.

Support provisioning across multiple protocols or connection types with Profile Editor – the intuitive graphical user interface in HP Smart Zero Client Technology. View your system settings and make changes in just a few simple clicks. Spend less time changing connection properties, disabling USB ports, enabling WiFi and creating fail-over rules.



Plug-and-deploy with Smart Client Services Keep it secure

Quickly and easily pre-configure your thin clients with HP Smart Client Services – a server-based application included with HP Smart Zero Technology. Simply connect your client to the network. HP Smart Client Services will automatically configure and connect to your host environment. From there, administrators can apply the settings of their choice to many clients at once.

The HP Smart Zero Client Technology moves the desktop environment to the server where it can be secured. By utilizing read-only firmware with no published APIs, the Smart Zero Client Technology software minimizes risk to each desktop in the business environment. In the unlikely event that an attack reaches a desktop, the threat will be isolated and eliminated upon reboot. HP Smart Zero Client Technology can be deployed with HP Flexible Series thin clients and HP Smart Zero clients.
