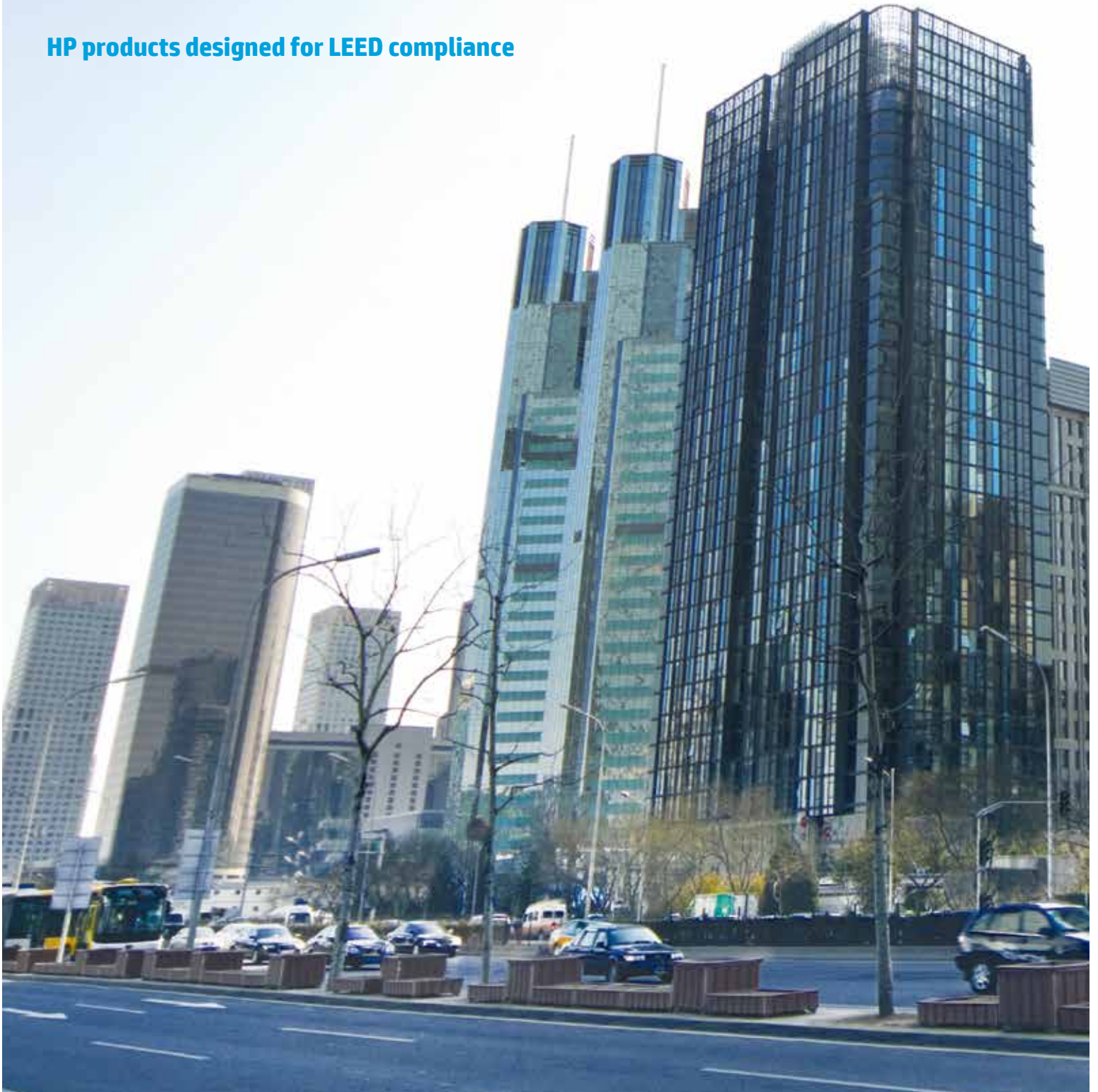

## Information about LEED

### Background

The most common building certification for environmental sustainability is the U.S. Green Building Council's Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Green Building Rating System™ [usgbc.org/DisplayPage.aspx?CMSPageID=222](http://usgbc.org/DisplayPage.aspx?CMSPageID=222). LEED is a third-party certification program and the internationally accepted benchmark for the design, construction and operation of high performance green buildings. LEED promotes a whole-building approach to sustainability by recognizing performance in five key areas of human and environmental health: sustainable site development, water savings, energy efficiency, materials selection and indoor environmental quality. LEED v3 was announced on April 27, 2009 and includes Rating Systems for both New Construction [usgbc.org/DisplayPage.aspx?CMSPageID=220](http://usgbc.org/DisplayPage.aspx?CMSPageID=220) and for Existing Buildings [usgbc.org/DisplayPage.aspx?CMSPageID=221](http://usgbc.org/DisplayPage.aspx?CMSPageID=221)

### Are HP Products LEED Certified?

HP frequently receives customer questions about "LEED certified" products or how HP products can contribute to LEED certification. To appropriately answer the question, it is important to know that the LEED standards define expectations for the design and construction of buildings. In fact, one of the minimum requirements for LEED certification is that the project being certified "must be a building." Thus, technology products cannot be "LEED certified." In fact, the U.S. Green Building Council answers this specific question in one of their Frequently Asked Questions [documents](#). However, products and services do play a role and can help projects with credit achievement, but do not themselves earn project points.

### Are there incentives for customers to earn LEED certification?

LEED certified buildings qualify for tax rebates, zoning allowances and other incentives in hundreds of cities. In the LEED Rating System for Existing Buildings there are four credit points available (in the Materials and Resources section) that may be impacted by HP products and recycling services. The following are descriptions of the four credit points with comments and links to resources for the applicable HP offerings:

#### MR Credit 1

(1 point) Sustainable purchasing – ongoing consumables (paper, toner cartridges, cardboard, etc.)

**At least 60% of total purchases by cost meet one or more of the following:**

- 1) Contain at least 10% post consumer and/or 20% post industrial material.
- 2) Contain at least 50% rapidly renewable materials. Does not apply to HP Consumables.
- 3) Contain at least 50% materials harvested/extracted and processed within 500 miles of the project. Does not apply to HP Consumables.
- 4) Consist of at least 50% Forest Stewardship Council certified paper products.  
HP Everyday Photo Paper, HP Advanced Photo Paper, HP Premium Plus Photo Paper, HP Multipurpose Paper, HP Recycled Paper, HP Bright White Inkjet Paper, HP Premium Choice Laser Paper, HP LaserJet Paper; HP Brochure Paper, glossy; HP Premium Presentation Paper, glossy; HP tri-fold Brochure Paper, glossy are FSC certified and count toward the 50% target.
- 5) Batteries are rechargeable.  
All HP batteries, sold as accessories, are rechargeable.

#### MR Credit 2

(1 applicable point) Sustainable purchasing – durable goods

**At least 40% of total purchases are ENERGY STAR® qualified:**

Many HP products are ENERGY STAR® qualified and would count toward the 40% target for durable goods. A current list of HP products that are ENERGY STAR® qualified can be found at [hp.com/go/energystar](http://hp.com/go/energystar)

#### MR Credit 7

(1 point) Solid waste management – ongoing consumables

**Reuse, recycle or compost 50% of the ongoing consumables waste stream:**

Recycling of HP Inkjet and LaserJet cartridges as well as Large Format Banner/Media through HP Planet Partners program would count toward the 50% goal for ongoing consumables. Information on HP's Planet Partners cartridge recycling program can be found at: [hp.com/recycle](http://hp.com/recycle)

#### MR Credit 8

(1 point) Solid waste management – durable goods

**Reuse or recycle 75% of the durable goods waste stream:**
