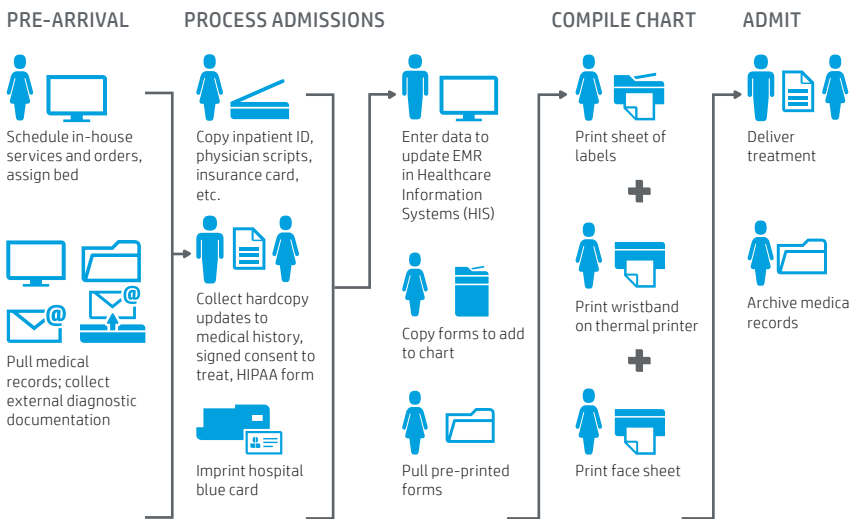

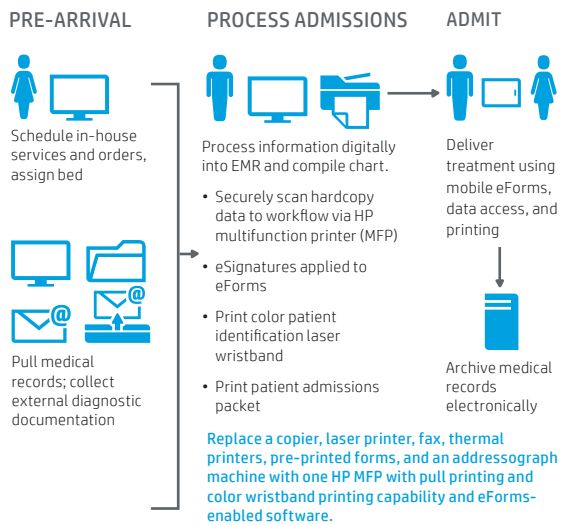
Before implementing HP healthcare solutions
