Easily print from your Apple iPad®, iPhone® and iPod touch® to an HP printer using AirPrint™². Printing is built-in. Just make sure your device and printer are operating on the same network¹.



Step 1: Choose your content
Open the content (photo, email, webpages, and more) you want to print and tap the "Share" icon.



Step 2: Select print
Swipe screen to reveal print button on bottom row, then tap the print icon.



Step 3: Print and enjoy!
Confirm the correct printer and print settings are selected. Tap "Print" and collect your pages!



Android™ (v4.4+)

Easily print from your Android v4.4+ device to an HP printer. Older Android™




Step 1: Launch
