- Has performed preventative and corrective maintenance on electromechanical devices
- Familiar with the use of a voltmeter
- Please insure that your operator knows which press and options you have so they can inform the instructor
- Please dress appropriately for the training sessions the training/pressrooms are cold.
 - Closed-toe shoes (safety shoes are recommended)
 - Long sleeve cotton shirt (Level 2 and higher)
 - Long cotton pants (all Levels)

Course Objectives

By the end of this class you will be able to:

- Understand the functions and interactions of the major press subassemblies
- Troubleshoot and repair basic electrical problems
- Troubleshoot and repair mechanical sub-systems
- Properly observe safety precautions to diagnose problems and perform repairs
- Perform mandatory preventive maintenance functions at prescribed intervals

- Optimizing print quality, increasing press uptime and press availability
