In addition to providing your operators with complete setup definitions for two existing book jobs, this service focuses on techniques and key settings to produce books that lie flat.

Service description



Activities	Description
Initial analysis includes	Working with up to two job/paper combinations of your choice, an HP consultant will analyse the book job content and your objectives for each. For each job/paper combination, HP will identify the ink density, and optimal press set-up for your press configuration.
Press setup includes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Optimal dryer configuration • Tension settings • Moisturiser setup
Knowledge transfer includes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing of HP best practices and experience • Onsite service, with hands-on training

Service scope

The service will be performed at your production site. Up to two book jobs (or job/paper combinations) for one HP PageWide Web Press are included per service unit.

Key deliverables

- Press configured with the optimal parameters for the first analysed book job
- Knowledge transfer for greater self sufficiency and operational confidence in producing short-run books

Requirements

Book job details to be shared with HP prior to arrival for the onsite portion of the service.

Customer to provide the consumables needed for press configuration and setup for the selected job.

Press availability window to perform the service in standard business hours. After initial analysis is completed, HP will communicate an estimate of the time window needed to perform the work.

Audience

Operators experienced in working with an HP PageWide Web Press can most benefit from the knowledge transfer and training aspects of this service.

Additionally, prepress team members can benefit from understanding the requirements for setting up the press for a book job.

Intended for up to five participants per service unit.
