

Printer cartridge recycling is good. Bulk recycling is even better.



What is bulk recycling? You send used printer cartridges to HP in boxes or pallets instead of one at a time.

Why bulk recycling is amazing



No more mailing individual cartridges! Just drop them in a collection box.



More efficient shipments = less fuel consumption + lower CO₂ emissions.



Bulk recycling is free for HP customers, just like single cartridge recycling.

By the pallet*
(75+ toner cartridges per month)

1. Ask your mailroom for some sturdy boxes, or order them from HP at hp.com/go/USSuppliesRecyclingMPS.
2. Drop used HP cartridges into the boxes.

3. When boxes get full, bring them to your mailroom.

4. Your mailroom will package boxes into pallets and schedule a free pickup with HP by going to: hp.com/go/USSuppliesRecyclingMPS.



By the box*
(10s of ink/toner cartridges per month)

1. Ask your mailroom for some sturdy boxes, or order them from HP at hp.com/go/USSuppliesRecyclingMPS.
2. Drop used HP cartridges into the boxes.

3. When boxes are full, tape securely.
4. Print a free shipping label from hp.com/go/USSuppliesRecyclingMPS and affix to box.

5. Bring boxes to your mailroom or give to your postal carrier.



By the envelope
(fewer than 15 ink cartridges a month)

1. Order envelopes from HP. Each envelope holds six HP ink cartridges. You can do this at hp.com/go/USSuppliesRecyclingMPS.

2. Drop used HP cartridges into the envelopes.

3. When envelopes get full, close them, and give them to your mailroom or your postal carrier.



BYOB
(Bring Your Own Boxes)

When you reuse surplus boxes, the environmental benefits of bulk recycling are even greater.
