What's included in the HP TX1 POS Solution 200?

Within the bundle is the HP ElitePad 1000 G2, HP Tablet POS Stand, HP ElitePad Connectivity and Smart AC Adapter (45w power supply also included), and a peripherals bracket.

Power your tablet and customize your POS for your business needs with the HP ElitePad Connectivity and Smart AC Adapter, which has a RJ-45 port for your network and four USB 3.0 ports for your POS accessories or payment device.²

- No IT support is needed to connect the hardware. The customer can simply follow the hardware set up guide instructions included in the box to get their solution up and running quickly and ready for business.

Depend on HP for peace of mind:

Be confident with a one-year limited warranty. Extend your protection up to five years with an optional HP Care Pack⁵. Keep your business running smoothly with HP BIOS Protection's security features and malware and virus deterrents on the tablet.

- The TX1 has a 1-year limited warranty on the HP ElitePad 1000 G2 and 3-year limited warranty on HP POS accessories.⁴ Additional coverage up to 5 years is available with optional HP Care Pack Services.⁵

Does it come pre-loaded with POS software?

The HP TX1 does not come pre-loaded with POS software, giving ISV partners the ability to choose a POS software application, as well as an option to integrate with a payment processor, to include as part of the solution so that it's truly a complete solution when marketed and sold to the small business end-user customer. ISV partners vary by country and by specific sub-verticals across Retail & Hospitality.

Does the solution have Chip-and-Pin capabilities?

The TX1 has the flexibility to accommodate chip-and-pin solutions, and other local payment accepting solutions, which vary by country.

What peripherals does the optional peripherals bracket support?

The bracket is compatible with the HP Single-head MSR (part# K1K15AA) and the HP Fingerprint Reader (part #QZ672AA). Please note that these peripherals are optional and are sold separately.

Is the tablet retail hardened?

The HP ElitePad 1000 G2 is not retail hardened.

Can the stand support any other HP tablets?

No, the HP Tablet POS Stand has been specifically designed for use with the ElitePad 1000 G2 only.

What type of security features does the solution have to protect from theft?

The tablet POS stand has several security features.

- It has a magnetic base which allows secure placement on a cash drawer, as well as two mounting holes on the foot of the stand that allows for mounting the stand to the countertop. If mounting is not desired, the stand can be placed on the countertop without being mounted.
- A thumb screw is also located on the back of the stand so that it can be tightened to securely lock the tablet in place while being used for point of sale purposes. The tablet can easily be removed by loosening the thumb screw.
- A slot for a Kensington lock is also on the back of the stand if additional security of the tablet is desired. A Kensington lock is not included as part of the bundle but may be purchased separately.
