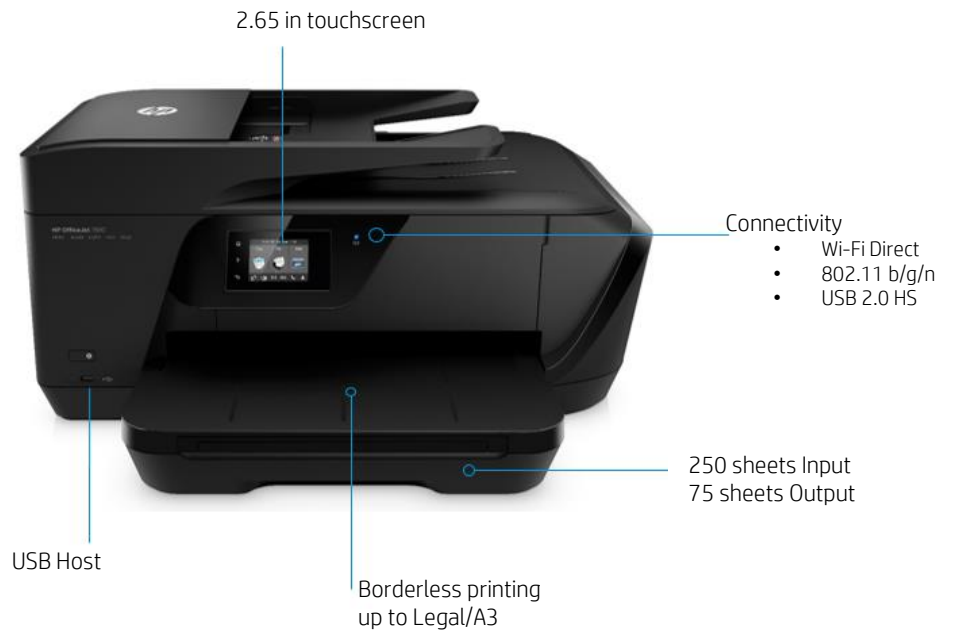

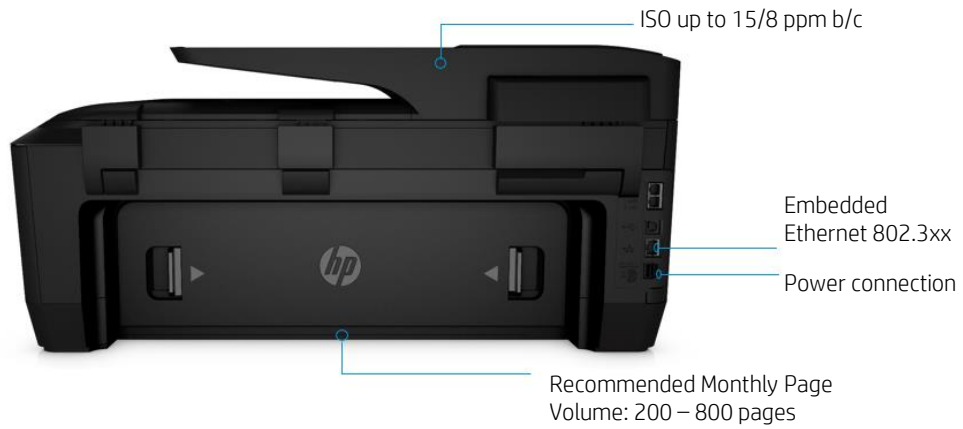

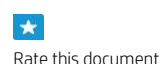
Front View
