Live-stream your whiteboard content

Share a crisp and vibrant real-time feed of your whiteboard activity with remote attendees through a secure online connection and a web browser.

Export to a PDF

Record and save your whiteboard's annotations, drawings, and more, and create Adobe® PDF slides to distribute after the meeting—no photos or transcribing required. Use the "Timeline" feature to scroll backward and forward through your content.

Control your guest list

Invite remote participants into your meeting with a private, unique URL that's viewable on a PC or mobile device through a browser.

Simple to set up

Mount the camera on the wall above your whiteboard, connect its cable to the control pad, and plug the power cord into any wall outlet. After your first-time setup, press Start to begin sharing.
