



Product naming for HP Managed printers and MFPs

HP LaserJet and PageWide Managed products use a unique alphanumeric code to identify the product's functionality, series, model specifications, and bundle. A similar system is used for HP LaserJet and PageWide supplies.

⁴ Some managed SKUs use three-digit model numbers only.

Managed HP PageWide cartridge naming examples⁵

Cartridges for managed HP PageWide printers and MFPs use a Selectability Number, helping customers identify the correct supplies for their product. Selectability Numbers are in addition to HP standard part numbers and do not correlate. For example, Selectability 976YC is P/N LOS29YC.

HP Contract PageWide cartridges have a two-alpha character suffix ending in “C” which signifies a “contractual” product. Black, Cyan, Yellow, and Magenta are differentiated by packaging descriptions.

Managed HP LaserJet cartridge naming examples⁵

Toner cartridges for Managed HP LaserJet printers and MFPs do not have Selectability Numbers, but rather use a unique numbering scheme. The last digit of the W cartridge number designates the toner color (0=Black, 1=Cyan, 2=Yellow, 3=Magenta). HP Managed LaserJet cartridges also have a two-alpha character suffix ending in “C” which signifies a “contractual” product.
