

Certificate of limited validity / different setting

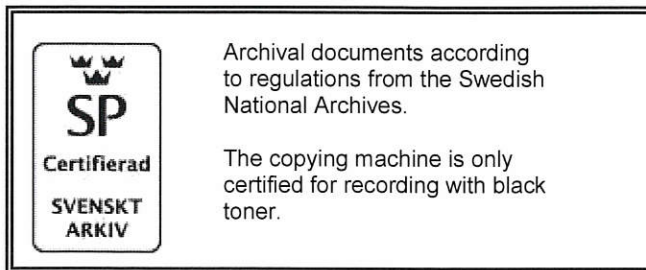
Certificate has been issued for you with limited validity.

The equipment is tested and certified with setting that differs from the original setting.

The condition is that all products with the same designation shall be marked with particulars about the deviation or the limitation. The marking shall be distinct, permanent and clearly visible. Copying machines and printers shall have a plate close to the control panel. The following examples act as guidance.

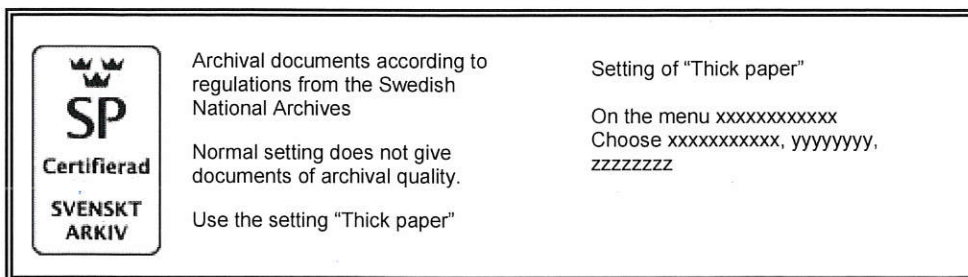
Example 1:

A colour copying machine is certified for the production of recording with black toner. One or more of the coloured toners do not meet the requirements.



Example 2:

A printer gives recording of archival quality with another setting than the normal. The change has to be made on the control panel or in the printing routine by the user. No change of the setting for each document is needed.



Example 3:

A printer gives recording of archival quality with another setting than the normal. The supplier changes the setting, in the program, so that this setting is chosen as "normal". It is possible for the user to change back to the initial setting.

Printers etc. shall be adjusted as recommended by the supplier. In this case, no marking is required.

Alternative to this label the supplier can ensure, in documented manner, that the user is informed about the deviation from the default setting.
