

Dear HP Partners and Retailers:

RE: Hewlett-Packard Products Subject to Fees under California’s Electronic Waste Recycling Act

The California Electronic Waste Recycling Act requires manufacturers to notify retailers annually by April 1 that certain electronic devices are subject to an electronic waste recycling fee.

Covered electronic devices with screen sizes greater than four inches on which the fee must be collected are:

- **Laptop computers with liquid crystal display (LCD) screens**
- This category also includes **mini notebooks, netbooks and Tablet PCs**
- **Desktop monitors containing LCD screens**
- DTSC confirmed that **All-in-One computers with integrated monitors** are a subset of the desktop monitor category and therefore are subject to the recycle fee
- DTSC confirmed that **LED backlit monitors with an LCD panel** are subject to the recycle fee
 - **Televisions** containing liquid crystal display (LCD) screens, Plasma TVs and TVs with CRTs
 - **Portable DVD players containing LCD screens**
 - Cathode ray tubes (CRTs) and cathode ray tube containing devices
 - Computer monitors containing (CRTs)

Current fee amounts are:

Screen Size

More than four inches but less than 15 inches	\$3
At least 15 inches but less than 35 inches	\$4
35 inches or more	\$5
