Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) from IT represents about 20% of the total WEEE stream. IT is a valuable resource for the re-use and secondary raw material markets. Processing and disposing IT WEEE incorrectly can be a human health and environmental hazard.

HP has been assessing the current conditions for electronics recycling and test methods to improve recycling processes and equipment. The purpose is to find the most financially and environmentally sustainable solution. HP has recycled computer and printer hardware since 1987. Our end-of-life programs benefit our customers and the environment, as well as our business. In addition to the millions of products that we recycle, we collect approximately 2.5 million hardware products each year that are refurbished or resold. HP's state-of-the-art processes ensure that unwanted hardware is recycled responsibly.

Recycling Services for Commercial Customers

Services Provided

- HP provides free recycling of equipment, in accordance with applicable local guidelines and with the Electronic Industry Code of Conduct (EICC)
- A certificate of destruction is supplied
- Additional services can be provided on demand
 - Collection of equipment from the customer's site
 - Equipment removal
 - Secure data destruction
 - Serial number tracking

Costs for additional services will be calculated individually, based on the current market price.
