Nigerian authorities sweep major counterfeiter off market



- ▶ Raiding several premises in late March, authorities in the Lagos area successfully disrupted a major criminal organisation involved in manufacturing fake printing supplies for HP printers and providing fake components to other counterfeiting companies.
- ▶ In total, more than 167,000 illicit items were seized, including ready-for-sale counterfeit cartridges as well as fake security labels and packaging.
