

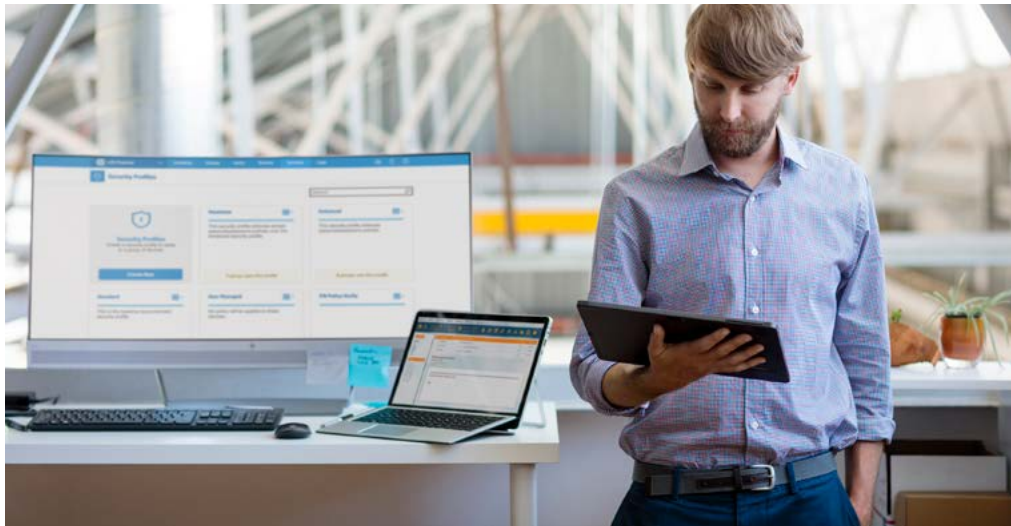


Agile methodology in IT can prevent an avalanche of complexity
