Please refer to the HP EliteBook x360 1030 G3 user guide for instructions on cleaning this product. Here are additional instructions for cleaning with specific germicidal wipes.

- First turn off the computer to prevent electric shock or damage to components.
 - Disconnect AC power
 - Disconnect all powered external devices
- If there is any visible soiling, wipe the exterior of the computer with a soft, water-dampened cloth to remove the soil as needed.
 - The cloth should be of dry microfiber or a chamois (static-free cloth without oil), or static-free cloth wipes.
 - The cloth should be moist but not wet. Water dripping into the ventilation or other points of ingress can cause damage.
 - Please do not use fibrous materials, such as paper towels, as these can scratch the computer. Over time, dirt and cleaning agents can get trapped in the scratches.
- Next, use the following germicidal wipes* to clean all exposed surfaces of your computer. Remember to start with the display and finish with any flexible cables. (Refer to the directions for use provided by the manufacturer of the wipes).
 - **Clorox Healthcare® Bleach Germicidal Wipes**
 - Sodium hypochlorite 0.1%–1.0%
- Allow the unit to air-dry before use.

Please do not use cleaners that contain any petroleum-based materials such as benzene or thinner. These may damage the computer.
