Reporting

Certificates of Destruction and specialized reporting are available on request.

A Certificate of Destruction is a document that verifies that products were destroyed through the recycling process, that the data on the products cannot be accessed by anyone else, and that the recycling methods used met or exceeded applicable environmental regulations.

HP also offers specialized reports that cover details requested by an organization, such as a list of the serial numbers of the items recycled and data sanitization reports.
